



2020-2021 Student Supply List: Grades 6, 7, & 8

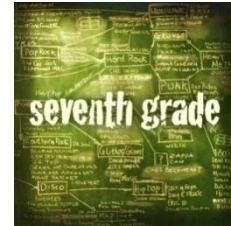
Dear Parent/Guardian:

Your child will need the following items for the 2020-2021 school year. You may purchase these items at your convenience over the summer vacation. Please note that your student **MUST** bring these materials with them on the **first day of school**.

***Additionally all students in grades 6-8 must bring in their PPE Supplies as well.**

All Subjects As Indicated:

- ☐ 1 (5 Star) College Ruled 5 Subject Notebook (Math)
- ☐ 5 (5 Star) College Ruled 1 or 3 Subject Notebooks (Social Studies, English, Religion, Literature, and Science)**
- ☐ 1 11"x14" spiral bound drawing book, good paper, at least 50 pages (Art 7th & 8th only)
- ☐ 3 2-Pocket Laminated Folders or an accordion folder
- ☐ 1 Flash Drive (thin, no characters, used in ALL subjects)
- ☐ 1 Package of Colored Pencils
- ☐ 3 Black or Blue Pens, Red Pens
- ☐ Index cards with box / holder (3x5 or 4x6)
- ☐ 4 JUMBO book sox (preferably cloth)

- ☐ 12 inch ruler
- ☐ 6 inch ruler
- ☐ 0.5 Mechanical Pencil and Extra Lead (Math)
